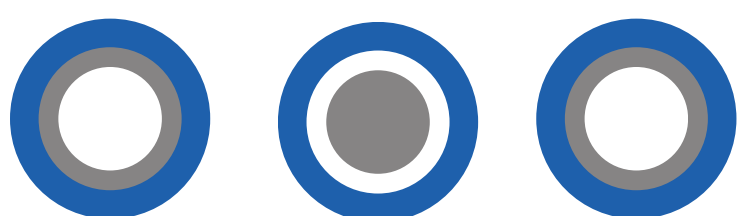




# Javier Nava

Javier Nava works as a Mass Violence Relief Specialist for the National Compassion Fund. Javier has been a victims' rights advocate since recovering from a gunshot to the abdomen on June 12, 2016 when a gunman entered the Pulse nightclub in Orlando, FL and began shooting. Four of Javier's friends were also murdered that night in a tragic mass casualty crime that killed 49 people and wounded 68. After the Vegas shooting, Javier travelled to meet with victims in both NV and CA.

Most recently, Javier helped the victims of the Wal-mart shooting in El Paso, TX where 22 shoppers were killed and 25 others were wounded or injured. He also helped victims of the condo collapse in Surfside, Florida. Javier also travelled to Washington D.C. to talk to House speaker Nancy Pelosi and also Rep. Gabby Giffords (herself a wounded survivor of the Tucson mass shooting) to advocate for sensible gun laws. Javier has worked on more than 5 mass shootings.



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
